Family Planning



Family Planning Services are confidential and are offered to both men and women. Services include the following:

- Family planning
- Birth control counseling and education
- Reproductive health exams
- Prescription and refills of birth control
- Insertion/removal of birth control devices

Pregnancy testing is also offered and includes referral for prenatal care, Social Services, WIC, and Pregnancy Care Management, if needed. **Appointments for Family Planning Services are preferred.**

Immunizations



We provide all required childhood immunizations, as well as many adult vaccines. Please call for more information about available vaccines. Immunization services are available daily.

Child Health

JCHD offers well child check-ups, school health exams and immunizations daily by appointment. Sports physicals and sick child visits are offered when a medical provider is present. Child Health services covers children ages birth to 21 years old.

STD Clinic

JCHD offers STD screening, counseling, treatment and education services daily, as well as diagnostic physical exams when a medical provider is available.

Tuberculosis

Tuberculosis (TB) skin testing is available every day of the week EXCEPT Thursday. A nurse can read skin test results any day of the week. JCHD also coordinates diagnostic services and provides treatment for tuberculosis disease.

BCCCP & WISEWOMAN

The Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program (**BCCCP**) provides free cancer screening services for eligible women.

For clients enrolled in BCCCP, we also offer the WISEWOMAN Program (**WW**), whose mission is to serve women ages 40-64 to improve their overall health and prevent, delay, or control cardiovascular and other chronic diseases.

Case Management

Assistance with making medical choices is provided to pregnant women (**Pregnancy Care Management**), families with children 0-5 who may have many medical needs (**Care Coordination for Children**) and disabled adults with Medicaid and Medicare (**Community Alternative Program for Disabled Adults - CAP/DA**).
